#### Member Numbers

- Usually lose about 15-20% per annum at 31<sup>st</sup> March subs renewal, but replace them each year over summer
- Membership stabilised in last 2 years
- BUT Now also have 6 affiliated clubs:
  - QRC, Sea Cadets, PE Dragons
  - EUSC, Dundee USC, & St Andrews USC
- So actual "member" number is probably around 500 now



#### Membership Analysis

- We have several categories of sailing activity:
  - Yacht Racing
  - Dinghy Racing
  - Yacht Cruising (& crew matching)
  - Sunday morning race training (& crew matching)
  - Club boats mentoring
  - Club boats hire
- In last 5 years Membership Racing numbers fallen, Cruising increased.
- Membership is now approx. > 50% Racing, >40% Cruising.
- Approx. 80% members don't own a boat, so 'member development' and 'crew matching' are very important.

  - Saturdays: Spring, A, B, C, D, E, Autumn & Winter series
  - Saturday Trophy mini-series: 6 (with CB starts)
  - Monday Funsails: 17 sessions



#### 2024 Club Racing - Wed Yachts

- 27 Wednesdays 3<sup>rd</sup> Apr 9<sup>th</sup> Oct (Not 5<sup>th</sup> June & 16<sup>th</sup> Oct)
- Plans for 54 Wed races Div-(1+3) & Div-2
- Pier starts: 12 days; CB starts: 15 days
- Similar format as in 2023
  - Easter (6-race), A & B (6), Twilight (4) & Night (3) series
  - Series results dual scoring on BH & RH
  - Club & RNLI trophy races
  - Solar-powered race mark lights on S, F, Z & L




#### 2024 Club Racing - Sun Yachts

- Racing most Sundays 31<sup>st</sup> Mar 15<sup>th</sup> Dec
- AM race training if races start after 12:00
- Similar Sunday racing format as in 2023:
  - Pier starts, 'on-the-water' OODs & self timed finishes
  - Sun A & B series, normally starting at 14:00
  - Longer races (Bosun's Locker, Three Inches & Queen Margaret)
  - FCYC/RFYC Edinburgh Regatta on 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> August
- Autumn 6-race & Winter 5-race series with CB starts



#### 2023 Yacht Racing - Wind Limits

- Wind limit guidance issued for OODs for Pier Starts
- Using Forth Bridge website anemometer data
- SI 7.8 OOD option to make Night/Twilight race 'Restricted Sail'




Twilight & Night Series Races							
Yacht (7m) Wind kt	Bridge (55m) Wind mph	Race Officer Guidance - Actions Before Start Sequence					
>18 kt	>25 mph	Declare race will be under Restricted Sail rules. No spinnakers or gennakers may be set.					
>20 kt	>28 mph	If a squall occurs that should pass through, display flag AP to postpone the start until the wind drops to <20 kt. Explain delay on VHF.					
>25 kt	>34 mph	Before yachts leave their berths, display flag AP to postpone start & use VHF to advise yachts to stay in marina until wind is <20 kt. Extend the time between AP removal & 1st warning signal to give crews time to rig and reach the start line.

#### 2024 Racing - Changes

- Pier start/finish: Mark F repositioned & mark W deleted
- Div-3 yachts will start 5 minutes earlier than previously
- Recommended course matrix 5x7 with 2 kt wind steps
- Courses will be 2-rounds only (No short 3<sup>rd</sup> rounds)
- Considering alternative Div-1 courses with 1-round
- Considering alternative night courses using navigation marks



## Cruising Report



#### **PEYC Cruising Section 2023**

 Cruising membership continues to increase: 90% since Dec 2019 and 6% on last year

- Dec 2019 : 72 Dec 2021 : 95

- Dec 2022 : 127 Dec 2023 : 135

- Thursday evening cruising
  - 13 yachts participated
  - 54 different crew members participated over the course of the season
  - Average of 12 crew allocated to yachts each Thursday
- Sunday day cruises in company to Blackness, Bo'ness, Aberdour



#### PEYC Cruising Section – Plans for 2024

- Continue successful Thursday evening cruising: matching skippers and crew, recommended start times
- Full programme of Sunday day cruises in company to harbours/clubs around the Forth (see calendar)
- Understand what cruising club members are looking for when they join
- Ensure cruising section committee reflects the views and wishes of the wider cruising membership
- Produce cruising section charter (what we want to do and how)

- 124 Mentored sessions 69 Individuals in 2023 (only 18 also booked 707s)
  - potential & new members wanting to learn to sail
  - members want to be Accredited to helm
  - members who just want to practice manoeuvres with a mentor
- 40 Hire sessions 28 Accredited Helms now
- 6 Theory Practice Sessions by Scot Corrigan
- BIG THANKS to the 'Tuesday Team' who maintain all our boats!
- PROBLEMS Lack mentors, bilge keel, self-tacking jib, ICC Assessments

## Treasurer's Report



#### PEYC Accounts – Year ending 31 Oct 2023

- Broadly Similar to the previous Financial Year however
  - Immediately after 310ct 2022 the club bought Beamer for £29,995
  - Faithful was traded in for £7,500
  - At the end of March 2023 club funds were <£1,000</li>
  - At the end of March 2024 club funds (estimated) £15,000

#### **SUBSCRIPTIONS 2023**

- The club trades at a very modest profit.
- We used up most of our cash savings previously on assets: the new clubhouse, new cruising boat 'Nimrod', and new committee boat 'Beamer'.
- (Although we have sold Nimrod in 2024 accounting year)
- Our cash balance is lowest prior to annual subscriptions on 31<sup>st</sup> March.
- We need to build up our cash savings again.
- Modest subscription increases are proposed this year.


- Junior (under 18) Free
