

PEYC Emergency Phone - 2022


For the Twilight & Night yacht series, the Race Box emergency mobile phone provides a backup method for boats requiring assistance to contact the Race Officer, if they are unable to make contact using VHF. It is an Alcatel 1066G mobile with 'Pay as you go' SIM card.

The phone is programmed to switch on at 18:00 and off at 23:00 for the Twilight & Night Series and the Race Officer should check that it is on by pressing any button and unlocking the keys by pressing the top LHS (-) button. Please leave it connected to the charger.

To switch on the phone on other occasions, disconnect it from the charger and press the second top button on the RHS until the start-up sequence initiates. Once switched on, please reconnect it to its charger and ensure the charger is powered up.

To confirm if a missing yacht is in marina, use VHF Chan 77 or owner's mobile on Fleet List.
